Subject: Designating the Office of Administrative Hearings to provide a Hearing Officer for a Reduction in Force (RIF) Hearing

Background

Notices of dismissal due to reduction in force were sent to affected academic employees on November 16, 2020. The notices included the following:

You have ten (10) days from the date of this notice to make a written request for a hearing. An employee who requests a hearing is entitled to one formal, contested case hearing, pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act (RCW 34.05). Such hearing shall be concluded by the hearing officer within sixty (60) days after written notice of the reduction in force has been issued. Pursuant to Article XI.E.2.o.(2) the only issue to be determined by the hearing is "whether, under applicable policies, rules or bargaining agreement, the particular academic employee(s) advised of severance are the proper ones to be terminated."

A written request from one (1) affected academic employee was received within ten (10) days from the November 16, 2020 notice date.

Per Article XI: Formal Procedures Relating to the Dismissal of an Academic Employee, Section E.1.a. Hearing Officer – Appointment:

Upon receipt of a request for a hearing from an affected academic employee, the College President shall notify the Board of Trustees and request that the Board appoint an impartial hearing officer after consultation with the Federation President.

Recommendation

That the board approve designating the Office of Administrative Hearings to provide a Hearing Officer for a Reduction in Force (RIF) hearing.
