When you completed your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) you answered yes to one of the unaccompanied homeless youth questions. Definition:

- **“Homeless”** means lacking fixed, regular and adequate housing, which includes living in shelters, parks, motels, camping grounds, cars, abandoned buildings or temporarily living with other people because you have nowhere else to go. Also, if you are living in any of these situations and fleeing an abusive parent, you may be considered homeless even if your parent would otherwise provide a place to live.
- **“Unaccompanied”** means you are not living in the physical custody of your parent or legal guardian.

- If you check one of the three boxes below, you **must provide documentation by submitting page 2** of this form to an appropriate certifying official who can verify your living situation.
 - ☐ At any time on or after July 1, 2024, did your high school or school district homeless liaison determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or were self-supporting and at risk of being homeless?
