

2025-2026 Federal Direct PLUS Loan Request Form for Parents

The Federal Direct Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS) may be obtained by parents to cover their dependent student's educational costs up to the student's full cost of attendance. The student must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits required for their program of study.

Who can Borrow: To borrow a Direct PLUS Loan for a student, the borrower must be the student's biological or adoptive parent, or in some cases, a stepparent as well as a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen. A stepparent is eligible to borrow a Direct PLUS Loan if he or she is a parent in accordance with the instructions on the FAFSA. A legal guardian is not considered a parent for federal student aid (FSA) purposes. Note: A credit check is conducted on all PLUS loan applicants.
